



March Rules & Regulations

1. **LINE UP:**

- a. Specific line up locations, time of arrival, and exact march route will be communicated via email to all entries a few weeks prior to the event.
- b. All entries will be lined up, at the discretion of the Pride March Director and Logistics Team, based on the type of marching unit, logistics, and presentation significance.

2. **ENTRY:**

- a. The Pride March will last approximately one hour dependent and will conclude upon arrival to the festival location at Malls B & C.
- b. If you have any questions regarding the timeline, or route, please send us an email to info@lgbtcleveland.org

3. **PRIDE MARCH REPRESENTATIVE:**

- a. Each community group registered is required to designate a "Pride March Representative". The Pride March Representative will serve as the primary contact with Pride in the CLE™ and be able to assist the Festival Director with set up and control of the marching unit prior to, during, and after the Pride March.
- b. The Pride March Representative will report to the Festival Director or Volunteer for entry verification and line up assignment no later than 1 hour prior to the step-off time.

4. **ETIQUETTE:**

- a. Pride in the CLE™ participants must understand and agree that this Pride March is intended to be, and at all times shall be, a Family Friendly event.
- b. Therefore, participants shall not display any materials, or behave in any way, that are obscene, sexually explicit, pornographic, or indecent as described in City, County, State, and Federal law.

5. **MARCH ROUTE ASSISTANCE:**

- a. The march must keep moving. Volunteers and Cleveland Police will be on site to quickly move any unit along, or out of, the route.

6. **INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION:**

- a. Individuals without an affiliated business or organization who wish to participate in the march must still register.
- b. Please note that if you are a part of an organization that has registered to march, you do not need to register.
- c. All individual registrants must be at least 18 years of age.
- d. If under the age of 18, you must be accompanied with a legal guardian who is at least 18 years of age.

7. **COMMUNITY GROUP REGISTRATION:**

- a. All community groups, organizations, businesses, employee resource groups, or corporations that intend on marching must still register regardless of status as Pride Partners or Vendors.
- b. When registering, please estimate how many participants you plan to have march with you.
 - i. **Please contact info@lgbtcleveland.org with any participant updates.**
 - ii. **Should you expect an increased or decreased amount of participants after you register, please do not re-register and simply contact us with changes.**

As a Pride March participant, certain guidelines must be followed to help the march run efficiently, and to ensure the safety and security of other participants and onlookers.
